Emergency Contraception ("The Morning-After Pill")

Emergency contraception (EC) works after sex to stop a pregnancy before it starts. It is most effective if taken within 24 hours after unprotected sex and no more than three days after. Search by zip code to find where to get EC near you. Women and men ages 17 and older can buy EC without a prescription at pharmacies. Prescriptions are required for those under age 17.
