☐ <u>Ambassador/Usher</u> – Volunteers greet patients coming in through main entrance, assist with giving directions to families, patients and visitors, and/or escort and transport to their destinations.

☐ <u>Friendly Visiting</u> — Patient visits on in-patient hospital floors/rooms: talk, read, bring water, hand out magazines/books, and lift the spirits of hospital patients.

☐ Reach Out and Read — Read to children in pediatric waiting rooms - national medical model program.
☐ Research Volunteers – Data collection, literature review, survey administration.
